

The Timothy Fund

It is the responsibility of the church to send out called servants of God to share the Gospel of Jesus Christ with the world. Also it is the duty of a church to assist called servants to prepare for their mission. Therefore this is a recommendation that Crossroads Church help fund the theological seminary education of called out members of Crossroads at the Masters Degree level. This person shall have been a member of Crossroads for at least 3 years or has made a significant ministry contribution to the fellowship. The prospective student is to have publicly surrendered to a call to full time ministry before a local congregation. The Executive Staff in consultation with the Board of Trustees will serve as the team to determine the approval of each application.

Approved seminaries and universities will be any one of the Southern Baptist Convention sponsored institutions. Any other seminary must be approved by executive staff and the chairman of the Board of Trustees. Consideration will only be given to those seminaries that are accredited and hold to the inerrancy of Scripture.

The Timothy Fund balance on July 1 shall be the determining amount to be awarded in equal amounts for the Fall and Spring semesters. (Example: If the Timothy Fund balance is \$3,000.00 on July 1 and two students are approved then each student will be awarded \$750.00 for the Fall semester and \$750.00 for the Spring Semester.) The amount received by each student shall not exceed the normal tuition and book expenditures of a Southern Baptist Convention sponsored theological seminary. Funds will only be expended directly to the seminary with no check or cash being paid directly to the student. Applications for The Timothy Fund are due by July 1. Any exceptions to the application deadlines and disbursements must be approved by the Executive Staff Team in consultation with the Chairman of the Board of Trustees.
